Preamble

OSIEPE Practical Action, in conjunction with partners and the County Government of Kisumu in recognition of the need to share its model of CBO driven transformation, intends to host a groundbreaking ceremony cum fund raising event at its proposed headquarters in Awasi on **Saturday 10th December 2016**.

The efforts of community based organizations (CBOs) produce a sustainable mechanism for boosting efforts of public and private sector investments. OSIEPE practical Action, as a CBO, has demonstrated that this works through its unique model of quality of life transformation. The uniqueness of the expo will be built on a facilitated lesson learning as well as partnership and business deal-making platform to be combined with fund-raising. The platform will be an outstanding opportunity where lessons and partnership ideas will be shared as captured in OSIEPE model and partnership opportunities availed to various development partners, other CBOs, professionals, service providers and county governments. Due to the demand for an extensive livestock value chains platform a special focus will be put in launching the Kisumu County Dairy Value chain program.

The 1 day expo will bring together OSIEPE members, local, regional and international partners and leaders. A special interest is placed on other CBOs, development services providers, researchers, academia, input suppliers, development sector, media, youth and political leaders.

Objectives

The event will showcase OSIEPE model, mobile funds and other resources and profile the investment partnership opportunities that the CBO offers. The event aims at achieving the following specific objectives;

- 1. To mobilize resources including finances, capacities, equipment, ideas, partnerships and other forms of inputs to further OSIEPE course through the proposed construction of the group's Legacy Hub.
- 2. To show-case OSIEPE Practical Action [®] CBO model in order to place local stewardship as a priority for sustainable development.
- 3. To promote a market led approach to the extensive dairy value chain development and profile investment opportunities that unlock its commercial potential in Kisumu County
- 4. To provide a facilitated expert and stakeholder platform for learning and debate between citizens, professionals, leaders and other actors on development stewardship; and
- 5. To explore opportunities for OSIEPE group resource mobilization for group investments and scaling out of the model through strategic partnerships.

Expected Results

It is expected that the event will trigger local, county-wide and national/international engagements to remodel development and transformational leadership. In the long term, it is expected that the event will grow into a biannual County event bringing together leaders, citizens and other stakeholders in consolidation and learning around OSIEPE CBO development model.

Structure of Event

The event will be open to the public. Service providers and other participants (organized groups, leaders) have a waiver of participation but will be expected to contribute as part of the fund raising component of the expo. The event will comprise.

- I. Open exposition of OSIEPE model and services to its members and the public
- II. Open exhibition by selected service provides include research organizations, business entities, county government, banks, other CBOs
- III. Panel discussions on topical issues
- IV. Professional and expert engagement with OSIEPE members and citizens on their contribution to socio-economic development
- V. Leadership gala to deliberate on how leaders at different levels will commit to OSIEPE virtues and propel the model
- VI. Youth empowerment to unlock opportunities for entrepreneurship, leadership and professional growth
